We will endeavour to ensure that events do not change timings. We will let parents know with as much notice as possible if dates do have to change unavoidably.

As you will be aware, the Tour de Yorkshire is arriving in Castleford on Friday May 4th and is travelling straight past our school! We are going to watch the women's race in the morning from our field and have a Yorkshire picnic lunch. If your child normally has packed lunches and would like to join in, you will soon have the option to request this through Parent Pay. The men's race is scheduled to travel past school at approximately four o'clock. This is likely to cause travel disruption beforehand and afterwards. As a result, we have decided that parents can collect pupils from 2pm on this day if they feel they need to in order to be able to travel home. **This is not a requirement** and school will remain open but this option is open to you if you feel you may need it. Please let your child's class teacher know if this is the case for you.

I would also like to thank the parents who took the time to fill in our questionnaire, or attend our Parent Forum. We have produced an action plan based on what was discussed and should have the majority implemented shortly – enclosed with this letter.
