Dear Parents/Carers,

The children in Year 5 have the opportunity to take part in an exciting, three-day residential visit to Ingleborough Hall, Lancaster which will be linked to their topic work within school. The programme is specially designed to give the children the opportunity to work as part of a team with other pupils in Year 5 and to form new relationships with children in their groups.

The children will stay at a specially equipped adventure centre and the cost of the visit includes all activities as well as their food and accommodation. During their time at Ingleborough Hall, they will participate in adventurous activities such as:

- Caving
- Gorge Scrambling
- Orienteering

These activities will be led by certified instructors to ensure the safety and wellbeing of your child. The centre provides the children with the specialist equipment that they will need throughout their visit; such as walking boots, wellingtons and water proofs at no additional cost.

Additional activities will be led by school staff, including:

- Problem Solving
- Village study
- Adventure Playground
- Night walk

To ensure your child receives the best experience, we will be running two sessions. These will take place between Monday 28 January 2019 to Wednesday 30 January 2019 and Wednesday 30 January 2019 to Friday 1 February 2019.

If your child would like to attend the residential, please complete the return slip at the end of this letter. **Names will be drawn out of a hat on 20th April 2018** to ensure fairness as unfortunately places cannot be secured for all Year 5 children. You will then be notified by text if your child has been successful in receiving a place.

Healthy Schools

The cost of the visit is £150 per pupil so we are hoping that this early notice will help you to plan financially as the school has to make regular payments to the centre to secure the booking; so if your child secures a place the following payments are required via ParentPay:

- Within 7 days of receipt of text message confirming place £50 non-refundable deposit
- By 13 August 2018 £80 in total (non-refundable after 13/8/18)
- By 5 November 2018 £120 in total (non-refundable after 5/11/18)
- By 16 December 2018 £150 in total (non-refundable after 16/12/18)

Unfortunately, the above payment penalties are part of the terms and conditions of the booking centre and so must be upheld by the school. Cancellations made after the above dates will be subject to the charges detailed & cancellations made after 16/12/18 will be subject to payment in full.

If you would like to know more about the residential before committing to pay the deposit, please speak to a member of the Year Five team who will be able to answer your questions or visit www.ingleboro.co.uk for more information.

If your child receives a place on the residential you will be required to complete a medical form and attend a pre-visit meeting that will be held nearer to the time of the residential. This talk will be led by a specialist from Ingleborough Hall, who will be available to discuss the itinerary of the trip and to answer any questions you may have prior to our visit.
