



HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

At Castleford Park Junior Academy we strive to provide a caring ethos where everyone within school feels safe, confident, valued and respected. We aim to build on the children's experiences at home and to promote genuine partnership which will benefit the children's schooling.

School will:

- a) Be welcoming at all times.
- b) Encourage children to do their best at all times.
- c) Encourage children to take care of their surroundings and others around them.
- d) Inform parents of the children's progress formally at twice yearly meetings and through written annual reports.
- e) Inform parents about what the teachers aim to teach each term.
- f) Will endeavor to ensure that pupils feel listened to, respected and treated fairly at all times

Parents will:

- a) Make sure children arrive at school by 8.50 a.m. and collect them at 3.05 p.m.
- b) Make sure that children attend regularly and inform school of any reason for absence.
- c) Encourage their children to have a positive attitude to work and behave well in and around school.
- d) Help with activities sent home, particularly by reading to and with the child regularly.
- e) Ensure that children do not wear jewellery to school other than any ear studs which must be removed for P.E. and have their appropriate P.E. kit(s).
- f) Attend Parents' Evenings to discuss children's progress, twice yearly.
- g) Observe the school's procedures for safety, parking safely in the neighborhood and stand with children to ensure a calm start each morning ensuring they respect school property.

Parents will help their children to keep to our school's rules which centre around:

- Showing respect.
- Trying our best.
- Keeping yourself and others safe.
- Listening carefully and do as we are asked.
- Being kind, caring, friendly and helpful.
- Being polite, well mannered and honest.

Together we will:

- a) Support any child with barriers to learning
- b) Encourage the children to keep the School Rules
- c) Work together to ensure your child makes the best progress possible
