


February Challenge



Can you learn a poem, short story or nursery rhyme in a **different language**? What language did you choose and why? (1 Credit)

The **Winter Olympics** are running throughout February. What might you see at the Winter Olympics?

Draw a picture, make a collage, or craft an item to show us!

Some ideas: An ice skating rink, ski slopes, medals, the Olympic torch, bobsled track, the Olympic Rings, a stadium. (2 Credits)

Use the internet to find out how to make **rock candy** and have a go yourself!

With this fun science experiment you can watch the sugar crystals grow. For extra credit, complete an evaluation of your experiment— What can you find out, what do you predict will happen? What did happen? What did you learn? (Experiment = 1 Credit / Evaluation = 1 Credit)


Create your own **treasure hunt**. This could be around your home, garden, in the park or somewhere else. Draw a map or make some clues. See if someone you know can find the treasure! (2 Credits)



Sign up to a local **sports** or **athletics** club.

Research how to make a **Mobius strip**. Can you make one? Now experiment with your Mobius strip, you could try cutting it or drawing a line around one edge without taking your pen off of the paper to see what happens. (1 Credit)
