

Year 3 Topic Web

Summer 1 half term

Science: Light and Shadow:

Pupils will learn that they need light in order to see things and notice that light is reflected from different surfaces. They will also recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes. This will be done through written and practical Science lessons.

Literacy:

Following the Talk for writing structure: Imitate – Innovate – Invent. Starting looking at the book ‘The Arrival’ moving onto The Journey. Both fiction titles.

Indoor PE: Gymnastics

Pupils will learn a variety of travelling, jumping, rolling and balancing skills and understand how different body parts are capable of receiving weight. Pupils will also be able to move smoothly into and from a balance and link balances with travelling and rolling actions.

Music:

Making and playing musical instruments out of recycled materials to play and compose short pieces of music.

French: Healthy Eating

Children will be learning key words and phrases.

Outcomes:

- Make a musical instrument using recycled materials.
- Table top sale to raise money for refugees.
- Broaden their understanding of cultures and diversity.

Numeracy:

We will be covering Fractions, Shape, Measurement and Statistics. This will be carried out through a mixture of written and practical lessons where the children focus on building their fluency skills before moving onto problem solving and reasoning skills to extend their knowledge further.

RE

Children will be focussing on the different beliefs about God. They will be learning about a range of diverse cultures when discussing this.
