

Literacy

The children will be looking at a book called 'Lost Words' (Robert Macfarlane and Jackie Morris). They will be writing Acrostic poems and then Non-chronological reports.

Numeracy

During this term, pupils will start off the term consolidating and applying new knowledge of place value. We will then review using the four operations starting with addition and subtraction. Through the week, we will look at problem solving across a range of topics.

Humanities

We will be studying history and life from Stone Age through to Iron Age. The children will be learning about different aspects of life from these times including – Stonehenge – why and how it came to be.

PE
