

Year 4 Topic Web

Spring Term

Science: Sound and Forces

Children will investigate how vibrations cause sounds and how sound travel, as well as how sounds can change pitch and loudness. They will also be comparing how things move on different surfaces and how magnetic forces work.

Literacy:

Children will begin the term by investigating what makes a good myth then work on creating their own myths. We will also be looking at non chronological reports, play scripts and explanatory texts during the term.

Indoor PE:

Gymnastics Pupils will use a range of skills in order to develop a sequence including rolling, jumping, balancing and different types of movement at different level and speeds.

Dance- They will be working work creatively and imaginatively to create a group dance. They will be encouraged to use expression and to dance fluently and with control.

Music:

The children will create graphic notation creating a soundscape to enhance their storyboard / short film. They will use a range of percussion instruments and develop musical understanding of timbre and dynamics, whilst learning to perform together in groups.

French:

Children will revise parts of the body in French, zoo animals and learn to discuss their likes and dislikes.

Numeracy:

We will be focussing on developing mental and written methods for all operations, data handling and measures, including time.

RE:

5 Pillars Of Islam – The children will explore commitment to other faiths, exploring traditions and asking questions to find out more about the Islamic faith.

ICT:

The children will create story boards to plan their own Super Hero short film. They will use an ICT program to produce the film, adding captions and sound to complete their final version.

Art / DT:

Humanities:
